Paying for lunch just got easier

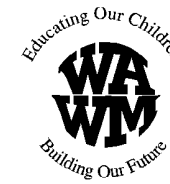
Do you often hear, "I need money for lunch," as your child heads out the door to school? With PaySchools, last-minute lunch payments aren't a problem.

Who can get free meals?

- ◆ All children in households receiving benefits from FoodShare, FDPIR or W-2 Cash Benefits.
- ◆ Foster Children
- ◆ Homeless, Runaway and Migrant Children (call 414-604-3119)
- ◆ Children in household's whose gross income is within the free limits on the Federal Income Guidelines.



Who can get reduced price meals?

- ◆ Children in household's whose gross income is within the reduced price limits on the Federal Income Guidelines.

Where do I return my completed application?

To apply for the free or reduced Meal Program, return the completed application to your child's school or the District Office at 1205 S. 70th Street.

Do I need to complete an application?

No! The West Allis-West Milwaukee School District is obligated to make sure all families have received the information about the Free and Reduced Meal Program but you are not required to complete an application. (Families who are Pre-Approved for the School Year need not apply.) If applying, please complete one application per household.

◆ **Households** that receives benefits from **FoodShare, FDPIR or W-2 Cash Benefits** need to list their name and case number (not Quest or Social Security Number), then follow the instructions on the application.

◆ **Homeless, Runaway and Migrant Children** need only **check the box** indicating their status and then list the students' name, grade and school. If you haven't been told your children will get free meals please call the district office at 414-604-3119.

◆ **Approved last year** Your child will be grandfathered for the first few days of this school year however, you will need to complete a new application every year.

◆ **WIC Approved** may be eligible. Please complete an application.

◆ **Late Applications** may be completed throughout the year if your income changes, your household size increases or if you start getting FoodShare, FDPIR or W-2 cash benefits or other benefits.

Who should I include as members of my household?

- ◆ All people living in your household, related or not.
- ◆ You must include yourself and all children living with you.
- ◆ Also include household members temporarily living away from home, such as college students.

How much do meals cost?

- ◆ **Reduced Priced Breakfast** is \$0.30
- ◆ **Full Priced Breakfast** is \$1.30
- ◆ **Reduced Priced Lunch** is \$0.40
- ◆ **Full Priced Lunch** is \$1.80 for Elementary Students
\$1.95 for Intermediate Students
\$2.05 for High School Students



What if I disagree with the decision?

- ◆ You should talk to your school officials.

- ◆ Yes, and we may also ask you to provide written proof. List the amount you normally receive if your salary varies from month to month.
