### 2008-09

Played in 30 games and started 29 contests for the Bobcats ... named a First-Team Academic All-Southland Conference selection ... earned the Bobcat Award for the second straight season after displaying the consistent attitude and effort throughout the year ... averaged 10.0 points per game ... scored in double figures in 13 games ... netted a career-best 32 points at Rice ... tallied 22 points against Northwestern State ... netted 18 points at UT Arlington ... scored in double figures for the first time and led the Bobcats with 17 points versus Huston-Tillotson ... also led Texas State with 16 points at Central Arkansas ... tallied 14 points versus Southeastern Louisiana and 13 points against Lamar, McNeese State and Texas A&M-Corpus Christi ... recorded five steals against Northwestern State ... recorded two blocked shots against Nicholls ... showed good range last season, shooting .398 from beyond the arc, good for sixth in the conference ... third in rebounding with 4.3 per contest.

### 2007-08

Sat out after transferring from Akron...received the team's Bobcat Award for having the most consistent attitude and effort throughout the season.

### Akron

Played in 43 games and made one start during his two seasons with the Zips... averaged 2.1 points per game during his career...averaged 1.8 points per game as a sophomore...scored a season-high seven points, had one rebound and two assists in road win at Duquesne...scored six points in a Mid-American Conference game against Western Michigan...averaged 2.3 points per outing as a freshman...lone career start came against Mississippi State in the semifinal round of the San Juan Shootout that year...scored a career-high 10 points in his first collegiate game against Denison...had a nine-point performance against Mount St. Mary's in the opening round of the San Juan Shootout...grabbed a career-high of five rebounds against Clemson in the championship game of the San Juan Shootout.

### High School

Averaged 23 points, 10 rebounds and three assists as a senior...played in the Wisconsin North-South All-Star game...team finished 16-8 his senior year and advanced to the sectional finals...started every game of his high school career, finishing with 1,691 career points...an all-area selection by the Milwaukee Journal Sentinel as a junior...led the Greater Metro league in scoring as a sophomore and junior as well as being an all-conference pick each of those seasons...also a pitcher for his high school's baseball team...four-year member of the honor roll and was involved in student government.
