

John Rybak Named To ESPN The Magazine/CoSIDA Men's Basketball Academic All-District Team

Senior forward is working on a MBA after graduating in 2008-09

San Marcos, Texas - Texas State senior forward [John Rybak](#) has been named to the ESPN The Magazine/CoSIDA Men's Basketball Academic All-District VI selection after posting a 3.5 GPA in his first semester of graduate studies in business administration. Rybak earned a bachelor's degree with a major in business marketing in 2008-09.

A two-year starter for the Bobcats, Rybak has started 21 of Texas State's 22 games this season and is averaging 10.0 points per game. He also leads the team in free throw percentage after making 40 of his 45 attempts for an 88.9 percentage. He also leads the team and ranks ninth among Southland Conference leaders with 2.0 three-point field goals per game. His 91 rebounds are third among team leaders and he is second among Bobcat leaders with 1.9 assists per game. He scored a season-high 30 points at TCU and also pulled down 10 rebounds against Texas earlier this year.

Rybak was an All-Southland Conference Academic First Team selection in 2008-09 and has been a member of the SLC Commissioner's Honor Roll two times. He also received Texas State's Oak Farms Dairy Academic Award each of the past two years and was named the Bobcat Award winner each of the past two years for displaying the team's most consistent attitude and effort throughout the past two years.

A native of Milwaukee, Rybak transferred to Texas State after playing two seasons at Akron.
