

# Graduation Planner



The Infinite Campus Graduation Planner provides parents, guardians, students, and staff with a tool to monitor a student's progress through his/her high school education. Students who are not on track for graduation because of credit deficiency should contact student services to begin credit recovery.

The Progress Tab allows users to view a color-coded grid of all courses within a student's grad plan and the progress they have made.

- Requirements that are either behind, in process or have not yet been entered into a student's schedule appear in red. For example; an eleventh grade student will not have twelfth grade courses scheduled.
- Requirements that are on track display in green.
- Overflow (excess) credits appear in yellow.
