

SUPERINTENDENT EVALUATION

In accordance with the Wisconsin Administrative Code, the West Allis-West Milwaukee Board of Education will evaluate the Superintendent's performance.

The primary purposes of the WAWM School District superintendent evaluation process are to:

1. Inform the Superintendent of the Board's expectations;
2. Improve educational performance, both for the Superintendent and, ultimately, the entire school district;
3. Improve future planning by reviewing the previous year's successes and lessons learned;
4. Provide input for the Board regarding the superintendent contract renewal and performance compensation decisions;
5. Serve as an accountability mechanism;
6. Fulfill legal requirements.
