

CARE OF SCHOOL/PERSONAL PROPERTY BY STUDENTS

No student may steal, deface, damage or destroy District property or another person's personal property.

Technology resources are classified as school property, and are owned by the District and are subject to the District's rights under contract and law. Students may bring technology into the District, including laptops, smartphones, MP3 players, etc. The District is not responsible for the security or safety of student owned technology while on school property or under supervision of a school authority.

Students who violate this policy shall provide restitution (replacement or repayment) in accordance with state law requirements or be subject to legal action and may be subject to other disciplinary action.

When District property is stolen, defaced, damaged or destroyed, the building principal shall report such to the Superintendent of Schools when the damage is considered excessive.
