

BOARD ELECTIONS

Members of the Board of Education shall be elected at the regular spring election in accordance with state law provisions. They shall be elected at large by a plurality of the electors of the District. The terms shall be overlapping, with three members being elected each year.

Any eligible elector who meets the applicable age, citizenship, residency, and voting qualification requirements, if any, prescribed by the constitutions and laws of the United States and the State of Wisconsin may be a candidate for Board membership. Interested electors wishing to declare candidacy for the Board in the primary and/or spring election shall receive, upon request, candidacy information as required by law from the school district administration.

An elected Board member's term of office shall commence on the fourth Monday in April. Before taking office, a Board member must take and sign an oath of office.
