

**REGULAR BOARD MEETINGS**

The Board of Education shall meet at least once each month and at other times upon the call of the school district president or upon the filing of a request with the school district clerk signed by a majority of the school board members, in accordance with state statutes and Board policy.

Board meetings shall be moved to a larger school facility within the District when evidence is made available to the Superintendent of Schools that a larger crowd than can be accommodated in the Board Room will be in attendance. When this occurs, provisions shall be made to videotape the proceedings for citizens to view at the earliest possible date.

All regular meetings shall be open to the public, except as specifically provided by state law.

Meetings may be adjourned to a specific date for the consideration of unfinished business.
