

EXECUTIVE SESSIONS

The Board of Education and its committees may meet in executive session only to discuss subject matter within the scope of state statutes. Only Board members, the Superintendent of Schools and persons essential to the discussion of the subject matter may attend executive sessions.

Executive sessions shall be called by the Board President, or in the case of committee meetings, by the committee chairperson in accordance with state law requirements.

Public notice of executive sessions shall be given in accordance with state law and established procedures. No business shall be taken up at an executive session except that which relates to matters specified in the notification thereof.

Because of the content of topics discussed in executive session, members present shall not disclose information detailed at executive sessions except as agreed to by the Board.
