

BOARD COMMITTEES

The Board of Education shall conduct the operations and business of the District through a committee of the whole structure. The functions of committees shall be fact-finding, deliberative, and advisory to the Board. The Board President shall annually appoint committee chairpersons after receiving preferences from individual Board members. Each committee chairperson shall appoint a vice chairperson who shall act in the chairperson’s absence.

All committees shall meet in accordance with established procedures and make recommendations to the Board.

At the request of the Board, the Board President shall appoint ad hoc committees comprised of less than the full membership of the Board for special purposes. The Board President may also appoint ad hoc committees if the need arises. The number of members appointed to each ad hoc committee may vary, but will include at least two Board members. The first named person shall act as chairperson, and he/she shall appoint a vice-chairperson. Ad hoc committees shall hold meetings in accordance with established procedures and shall be discharged on completion of their assignments.

The Board President and the Superintendent of Schools shall be advisory members to all special committees of the Board.
