

DUAL ENROLLMENT OF NON-PUBLIC SCHOOL AND HOME-BASED EDUCATION STUDENTS

Resident non-public school students and home-based private educational program students may be enrolled in courses or programs in the District under the following conditions:

- In grades K-8, enrollment will be permitted in subjects other than in the core subject areas of reading, language arts, mathematics, social studies, science or health. In grades 9-12, enrollment will be permitted in subject areas according to state statutes.
- Enrollment will be permitted on a space available basis.
- Enrollment will be limited to two courses per semester.
- The students must be academically qualified to meet the course prerequisites.
- In grades K-8, the course must not be available in the non-public school or home-based private educational program.
- Any transportation must be provided by the student or the student's parent/guardian.
- Participation will not be permitted in Wisconsin Interscholastic Athletics Association (WIAA) sponsored athletic programs as stipulated by WIAA regulations.
- Application for the first semester must be made prior to May 1. Application for the second semester must be made prior to October 1.

Approval or denial of a request will be provided in writing by the building principal. A decision denying a request may be appealed to the Superintendent of Schools.
