

**STUDENT REPRESENTATIVES TO THE BOARD**

Each senior high school in the District will annually select two student representatives to interact with the Board of Education. Students eligible for selection shall be sophomores, juniors or seniors. Each school shall determine the selection process that will be used in determining its student representatives. The selected representatives will serve from September 1 through June 15 during each school year.

The student representatives will serve in an informative role to the Board without voting privileges. Specifically, the duties and responsibilities of the student representatives shall be to:

1. Attend Board meetings to make brief reports regarding school activities to the Board.
2. Provide information to students at their high school regarding meetings of the Board in a variety of ways.

Orientation for newly selected student representatives shall be provided by the Superintendent of Schools and the representatives' building principal. Information related to topics to be considered by the Board shall be forwarded to the student representatives by the Superintendent on a regular and continuous basis. Information scheduled for discussion in executive sessions will not be forwarded to student representatives.

The Board shall evaluate the student representative program periodically. Any changes proposed in the program for a subsequent year shall be considered at the regular May meeting of the Board.
