

STUDENT CONDUCT ON SCHOOL BUSES

Student conduct on buses shall be in accordance with the same rules of conduct that apply at school and at school-sponsored functions.

It shall be the responsibility of the bus driver to maintain a safe and orderly environment. The authority of the driver shall be recognized and respected by students and their parents/guardians. Bus drivers and transportation officials are encouraged to report incidents of misconduct to school officials.

Violations of established rules of conduct may result in suspension from bus riding privileges, either temporarily or permanently, or other consequences. Parents/guardians of students not complying with the conduct rules shall be contacted.
