

STUDENT SCHOLARSHIPS

Students in the District shall be informed of known academic scholarships.

Literature concerning available scholarships shall be posted in the school building. The high school guidance counselor shall maintain records of available scholarships and shall notify students of such scholarship opportunities.

The District shall not discriminate in the acceptance and administration of gifts, bequests, scholarships and other aids, benefits or services to students from private agencies, organizations or persons on the basis of sex, race, color, national origin, religion, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation or physical, mental, emotional or learning disability or handicap. Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established procedures.
