

**WISCONSIN ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE SCHOLARSHIP TIE-BREAKER CRITERIA**

The state of Wisconsin provides academic excellence scholarships to the top senior scholars from each high school in the state. The number of scholarships available from each high school is based on the school's enrollment.

In those instances where student's academic records are equal and available scholarships do not match the number of qualified candidates, the following criteria shall be applied to determine who shall receive the scholarship:

1. Commitment to attend a University of Wisconsin (UW) institution, Wisconsin Technical College System (WTCS) institution, or private post-secondary institution in Wisconsin.
2. Total number of core college preparatory (English, mathematics, social science, natural science) credits as defined by the University of Wisconsin admissions requirements.
3. Total number of credits.
4. Highest ACT composite score received prior to February 1 of the senior year.
5. Lottery
