

**REVENUES FROM LOCAL SOURCES**

Money is collected locally through property taxes and is appropriately distributed to the general fund, the special education fund, the debt service fund, the sinking fund, community service fund and other funds within the school district budget.

The food service fund receives local revenue in collections from students, school employees, and other participants in the program. This money is deposited directly into the food service fund.

Student fees, admissions to plays, concerts and athletic events, for example, are deposited into the general fund, as are collections from the sale of supplies, tuition, rentals and other miscellaneous sources.

Interest on investments is deposited into the fund from which the money was invested.
